

Sangamon County High School Cheer & Dance Showcase Rules & Regulations

1. Registration Process:

- 1.1. All registration will be conducted using an online registration form, including coach's contact information and number of participants.
- 1.2. Number of participants must be provided in order to secure admission passes for the event.
- 1.3. As part of this inaugural showcase at the Illinois State Fair, we will be providing one \$300 performance payment for each participating school.
 - 1.3.1. All participating school districts will be required to complete a contract with ISF and a W9 to process payment.
- 1.4. All registrations must be received by May 31.

2. Divisions:

2.1. Divisions:

- 2.1.1. Game Day Cheer
- 2.1.2. Dance Team Halftime

2.2. Time Limits:

- 2.2.1. Game Day: 2:30 minutes
- 2.2.2. Halftime: 2:30 minutes
- 2.2.3. Timing will begin with the first choreographed movement or note of music, whichever is first. Timing will end with the last choreographed movement or note of music, whichever is last.

3. Music Guidelines:

- 3.1. All music used must be family-friendly and age appropriate. No suggestive or use of vulgar language is allowed.
- 3.2. All music must be accessible from the coach's phone or tablet on the day of the event.
 - 3.2.1. Each team is required to have an adult or alternate team member at the sound station to play the music.
 - 3.2.1.1. Each team will need to provide their music on their own device (phone, tablet, laptop). No CDs allowed.
 - 3.2.1.2. Please make sure that all devices have a headphone jack to connect to the sound system and are fully charged, volume turned up and placed in airplane mode.
 - 3.2.1.3. ISF will provide the necessary chords and dongles to play music through provided sound system.



4. Content Guidelines

- 4.1. All choreography must be family-friendly and age appropriate. No suggestive or use of vulgar movements are allowed.
- 4.2. Game Day Cheer Specific Guidelines
 - 4.2.1. Game Day will consist of Band Chant/Fight Song and Crowd Leading, each with a 1-minute time limit.
 - 4.2.2. Team shall transition quickly from Band Chant/Fight Song to Crowd Leading.
 - 4.2.3. No basket or waist level tosses are allowed.
 - 4.2.4. No inversions are allowed.
 - 4.2.5. No twisting released dismounts are allowed.
 - 4.2.6. No stunts or tumbling are allowed during entrance and exit.
 - 4.2.7. The use of signs, poms, flags, and megaphones is allowed for performances. No additional props are allowed.
- 4.3. Halftime Dance Specific Guidelines
 - 4.3.1. Halftime Dance may be choreographed in any of the following styles jazz, pom, kick, or hip hop.
 - 4.3.2. Dancers must have dance shoes on both feet.
 - 4.3.3. No running tumbling passes are allowed.
 - 4.3.4. No props other than poms allowed.

5. Sportsmanship

5.1. All participants, coaching staff, and audience members agree to display good sportsmanship throughout the Showcase and Best of Show presentation.

6. Schedule:

6.1. A comprehensive timeline for the event, including warm-up periods, performance slots, and scheduled breaks will be provided by July 31.

7. Best in Show Award:

- 7.1. A "Best in Show" banner will be awarded in both the Game Day Cheer Division and the Halftime Dance Division.
- 7.2. The "Best in Show" recipient will be determined by audience participation, with voting taking place after the presentation of participation awards.
