Entries

Assistance with entries is available at the Competitive Events Office, Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All entries must be submitted online on or before July 15, 2026. Fees will not be refunded. General Requirements & Criteria for Competition

1. General rules apply to all divisions in this department.
2. This department is limited to amateurs/non-professionals. An amateur creates items as a hobby or pastime and does not offer items for sale. Entrants must be a resident of Illinois. You do not have to be a winner at a county fair to enter the Illinois State Fair.
3. Articles must be the handiwork of the exhibitor, must have been finished within the last year (August 2025-August 2026) and not previously exhibited at the Illinois State Fair. Entries must be clean, odor free and free of spots. Entries must include stitchery. Entries not meeting specifications may be disqualified.
4. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
5. First place, rosette and/or special award winners may not succeed themselves in the same class/category/award.
6. Entry tags are prepared for each class entered, and will be available at entry check-in.
7. Entry tags must be affixed with a safety pin to each article. If there is more than one article per entry (mittens, place mats, etc.) they must be safety-pinned together. All garment entry tags must be safety-pinned to the left sleeve or left armhole. Garments are to be on hangers, except where stated otherwise by category.
8. Closed judging will be held Tuesday, August 11, 2026. The building will not be open to the public on Wednesday, August 12, 2026.
