Entries

No other type of entry will be accepted. Late entries will be accepted through July 31, 2024, with an additional \$50.00/exhibitor charge assessed.

Department Rules

1. Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies; and General Rules of the Open Livestock Division as previously stated.
2. Open Show exhibitors are reminded they must adhere to the Open Show registration and ring card distribution requirements in order to exhibit in the Open Show. Junior Show registration does not fulfill Open Show requirements. Further, all registration papers must be presented for check-in and ring card distribution in the Sheep Department Office 8:00 a.m.- the 12:00 p.m. day before a given breed show.
3. Purebred animals must be recorded in their respective National Breed Book as evidenced by official registration papers or certificate of registration and bear the American ear tag of the National Association and corresponding flock tag. No copies of registration or stamped duplicate of official registration will be accepted.
4. Proof of ownership must be evidenced by ownership prior to show and be presented for inspection by State Fair personnel or Sheep Superintendent. All entries must be entered under the name of the owner on the registration paper.
5. Exhibitors cannot show more sheep than the number of animals originally entered. Market lamb exhibitors are allowed six (6) entries in addition to two (2) premiere entries for a maximum of eight (8) entries in the Market Lamb Show.
6. A classifier will be used in the Open Sheep Show for purposes of breed verification. In all instances, the decision of the classifier shall be final. Official classification at the State Fair is not subject to protest.

7. The date shown on the registration papers will be taken as the effective date of ownership. However, in determining original origin or ownership, state or federal identification will take precedence over registration papers.
8. Exhibitors in the Open Breeding Sheep Show will be allowed two (2) entries per class and one (1) entry in pair and group classes.
9. No mature rams, aged nurse ewes/goats are permitted in the Sheep Show.
10. To be eligible to show in the Open Sheep Show of the Illinois State Fair:
 - a. All Breeding Animals must be properly identified by a Flock Tag & Scrapie Tag.
 - b. All market lambs must be properly identified with a Scrapie Tag.
 - c. All ear tags must be in place before arriving on the fairgrounds.
 - d. All identifying ear tags, tattoos or horn markings must be clearly visible for Superintendents and ring personnel.
11. All sheep must be penned in one of the Sheep Barns. All pens and stalls are to be assigned by the Superintendent or his/her assistants. Pens will be assigned on the basis of a minimum of three (3) head per pen, unless an exhibitor has only one (1) entry. Animals must be penned according to these assignments. Exhibitors are responsible for additional fencing if needed to separate or confine animals and all pens must be bedded with natural straw, wood chips or sawdust. Exhibitors will be allowed one (1) pen for tack. Additional pens, for any reason, will be at the discretion of the Superintendent.
12. No living quarters or tarps allowed in the Sheep Barns.
13. No enclosure of pens with tarps or any other material is allowed and no appliances, misters, swamp blasters, air conditioning units or cooling systems of any kind will be allowed in the barns.
14. Wethers and market ewe lambs will be shown together in market lamb classes.
15. All market lambs must:
 - a. Have been lambed on or after January 1, 2024.
 - b. Be docked and show ready slick shorn before check-in.
 - c. Weigh at least eighty-five (85) pounds.
 - d. Still have their milk teeth.
 - e. Wethers must show no sign of testicular tissue.
 - f. Free of any active fungus and/or sore mouth.
 - g. Be physically sound at check-in and show times.

All of these requirements will be examined by the Superintendent and his/her assistants who, along with the General Livestock Superintendent, shall have full authority regarding show eligibility.

16. Market lambs will be tagged at check-in and placed into weight classes based upon declared weights made at check-in. Practice scales will be available in the barns for use by exhibitors.
17. Market lamb exhibitors must fill out a check-in form which will be provided by the Superintendent at the mandatory Market Lamb Exhibitors' Meeting for each market lamb providing the full name and address, legibly written, of the exhibitor. The check-in form must be complete and submitted at the time of check-in and tagging. Registration papers verifying Land of Lincoln eligibility must also be provided for animals competing in the Land of Lincoln show. No phone nominations will be permitted.
18. A minimum of ten (10) market lambs of a given breed are required for a breed class. Otherwise, market lambs will show in an All Other Breeds (AOB) class.

19. All breeding animals must:

- a. Be docked and properly groomed for showing.
- b. Shropshire sheep must be slick shorn. Wool may be left below the knees and hocks and on the face and head from the poll forward; the remainder of the body is to be shorn to the skin within ten (10) days of the show date.
- c. Southdown Sheep must be slick shorn within five (5) days of the show. Wool may be left below the knees and hocks, and also below the eyes around the muzzle.
- d. Cotswold Sheep fleece should be a maximum of three (3) inches in length and no grooming oils should be used.
- e. Free of any active fungus and/or sore mouth.
- f. Be physically sound at check-in and show times.

All of these requirements will be examined by the Superintendent and his/her assistants who, along with the General Livestock Superintendent, shall have full authority regarding show eligibility.

20. Birth dates, as listed on the registration papers or certificates will be used to determine the class division for all breeding animals. Take the show date and count back to the birth date to determine the age and class for the animal. September 1 will be used as the base for computing the ages of lambs in all classes. Yearlings shall be subject to veterinarian's examination whose findings shall be final.
21. A commercial ewe may be a crossbred or a straight bred not eligible for registry. Commercial ewes and ewe lambs must be ear tagged or tattooed for identification.
22. Ring Cards will be issued for all sheep and must be worn by exhibitors in the showing at all times. Failure to do so is cause for ineligibility to show.
23. Unless otherwise defined by specific dates, some breeds will have yearling ewes divided equally into two (2) classes (A&B) determined by random draw after all sheep are entered and checked in. Exhibitors are limited to three (3) yearling ewe entries and two (2) premiums.
24. Artificial coloring of sheep will not be allowed. Lambs will be white towed before entering the show ring.
25. Muzzles may be used for animal health and welfare at the discretion of the exhibitor.
26. When lambs are being judged, they must have all four (4) feet on the ground. No excessive lifting of the animals. Slapping of animals will not be tolerated and is cause for dismissal from the showing.
27. Special awards presented by Breed Associations are the responsibility of those associations and not the Department Superintendent or Illinois State Fair.
28. No loading or unloading of trailers between the North and South Sheep Barns one half (1/2) hour before the start time of any beginning of show.
29. No washing of sheep in the sheep barns.
30. All pens and aisles are to be cleaned each day before 8:00 am.
31. No roller skates, skateboarding, scooters, inline skate, bicycles, tricycles, etc. allowed in or around the sheep barns at any time during the State Fair.

Special Definitions, Recognitions, and Awards

Exhibitor definition in pair and group classes: Where a pair, group of four, or flock is registered in the names of different members of a family residing on one farm, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for Premiere Exhibitor, Best Four Head and Young Flock.

Best Four Head: Four (4) sheep of any age and sex. All animals owned by one (1) exhibitor/farm.

Flock: Group to consist of one (1) yearling ram or ram lamb, two (2) yearling ewes and two (2) ewe lambs. All animals owned by one (1) exhibitor/farm.

Premiere Exhibitor Award: Upon decision of the Sheep Superintendent, a banner will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the Premiere Exhibitor in each sheep breed. In case of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest placing flock will be declared the winner.

Grand Champion Market Lambs: The Champion Market Lamb of each breed will compete for Grand Champion Market Lamb of the Open and Land of Lincoln Shows on Sunday, August 11. A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of each of the Open and Land of Lincoln Show Grand Champion Market Lambs of the 2024 Illinois State Fair.

Champion Pairs: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the Land of Lincoln Show Champion Pair of Ewe Lambs and Champion Pair of Ram Lambs of each Land of Lincoln eligible breed division at the 2024 Illinois State Fair.

Rules

1. The purpose of the Leadline Show is to present a class of well-groomed sheep, at halter, led by a participant clad in fashionable and becoming wool clothing. The underlying objective is to present an attractive and coordinated package entry which will promote the use of wool to both participants and the viewing public.
2. The Leadline Show is open to all exhibitors, male or female, at least nine (9) years of age and not yet twenty-two (22) years of age as of January 1, 2024. Exhibitors do not need to be actively engaged in the production or showing of sheep.
3. Exhibitor class ages shall be determined at the discretion of the Superintendent.
4. The exhibit will be judged on the attractiveness and originality of the costume, theme and the manner in which it is presented. A live sheep must be a part of the exhibit.
5. The exhibited animal must be a registered ewe, properly conditioned, groomed and fitted, and shown at halter in accordance with Illinois State Fair Sheep Show rules.
6. The type of outfit worn, whether it be dress, suit, slacks, skirt and sweater, etc., is optional. Of greater importance is if the garment is appropriate for the age and lifestyle of the participant?
7. There is no correct way to lead the ewe. A well-trained animal will respond with little assistance and with the lead strap in either hand of the participant.
8. The use of a blanket on the ewe is optional. If used, it should not cover more than two-thirds (2/3) of the animal. Excessive ornaments or baubles should not be used.
9. The use of gloves, boots, headwear, jewelry and other accessories by the exhibitor is also optional, whatever contributes to the overall neatness and attractiveness of the package is acceptable.
