No other type of entry will be accepted. Late entries will be accepted through July 31, 2024, with an additional \$50.00/exhibitor charge assessed.

Show Order

Show order will be posted in the showring and at the Pygmy Goat Office. However, show order is subject to change. Exhibitors should watch and listen for announcements.

Department Rules

- 1. Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies; and General Rules of the Open Livestock Division as previously stated.
- 2. Class ages shall be computed from the Opening Day of the Fair, August 8, 2024.
- 3. Exhibitors are allowed open substitution up to time of check-in.
- 4. All pens are to be assigned by the Superintendent or his/her assistants. Pens will be assigned based on a minimum of four (4) mature and a minimum of five (5) kids per pen. Animals must be penned according to these assignments. Exhibitors are responsible for additional fencing if needed to separate or confine animals.
- 5. Open Show exhibitors are reminded they must adhere to the Open Show registration and ring card distribution requirements to exhibit in the Open Show. Junior Show registration does not fulfill Open Show requirements.
- 6. Grade does may be shown but are ineligible for Land of Lincoln premiums.
- 7. Do not enter Championship Classes.

Special Awards

<u>Open Show Grand Champion Awards</u>: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Wether, Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Doe and Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Buck of the 2024 Illinois State Fair.

<u>Land of Lincoln Awards</u>: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the Land of Lincoln Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Doe and Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Buck of the 2024 Illinois State Fair.

<u>Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Herdsman</u>: Upon decision of the Pygmy Goat Superintendent, a plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the Grand Champion Pygmy Goat Herdsman. The following criteria will be used in the selection: 50 points on general appearance, 25 points on cooperation in entry and stalling process, and 25 points on show ring demeanor.
