### INFORMATION

#### Entries

Entry Fees \$1.00 per head; \$3.00 for Market Pens. Entries in all classes shall be made through the online fair entry system at the Illinois State Fair website. Entries in all classes shall be made through the online fair entry system at the Illinois State Fair website. Payment must be made via credit card at the time of entry. No other type of entry will be accepted. Assistance with entries is available at the Competitive Events Office, Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. All entries must be submitted online by 12 noon on July 15, 2024. Fees will not be refunded.

#### Show Schedule

Show will be held in Barn 26. Show order will be as classes are listed in the premium book. Show order is subject to change. Exhibitors should watch and listen for announcements.

#### Department Rules

1. Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies; and General Rules of the Junior Livestock Division as previously stated.
2. There are no requirements governing the movement of rabbits within the State of Illinois.
3. Junior Show exhibitors are reminded they must adhere to the Junior Show registration requirements in order to exhibit in the Junior Show and are encouraged to enter their animals in the Open Rabbit Show. Junior Show registration does not fulfill Open Show requirements.
4. Junior Show exhibitors may enter more than one (1) breed.
5. Tattoo or ear number will be required at the show site.
6. Exhibitors are allowed substitution within a class up to 9:00 a.m. the day of the show. Entry into additional classes is not allowed after July 15, 2024.
7. All Other Breed (AOB) classes are for animals in breeds not separately listed.
8. Each exhibitor must be present to show their own animals unless exempted in advance by Superintendent due to an identified, eligible conflict.
9. Rabbits should be brought to the fairgrounds in appropriate carriers and animals will be shown out of those carriers. All carriers must have a solid, leak proof bottom. Animals are not to be placed in State Fair pens unless directed by the Superintendent. Exhibitors wishing to overnight rabbits to participate in the Open Rabbit Show will be assigned pens by the Superintendent.
10. All appropriate paperwork must be completed and submitted to the Superintendent by 9:00 a.m. on show day.

11. All rabbits exhibited must be recognized breeds of the ARBA as listed in the Standard of Perfection. No crossbreeds are allowed. Breeds and varieties that have not been fully approved by the ARBA are not eligible to show at the Illinois State Fair.
12. Rabbits shown must be the property of the exhibitor, a part of his/her project, and must have a permanent, legible tattoo in the left ear. Animals with illegible tattoos or unhealed tattoos are ineligible to show. Additionally, exhibitors are responsible for having the ears of his/her animals clean and knowing the tattoo can be read by officials at the time of check-in and judging.
13. Any rabbit exhibiting signs of poor health and condition, or a pronounced defect or abnormality will be ineligible to show and receive premiums at the discretion of the Superintendent.

**Special Awards**

Awards: In Divisions 1300 to 1313, Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex will be awarded.

Best in Show: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the 2024 Illinois State Fair Best in Show.

Grand Champion Market Meat Pen: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Market Meat Pen of the 2024 Illinois State Fair Junior Rabbit Show. Additionally, the Grand Champion Junior Show Rabbit Market Meat Pen will sell at the livestock auction of the 2024 Governor’s Sale of Champions.

Junior and Senior Showmanship Champions: A plaque will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the Junior and Senior Showmanship Champions of the 2024 Illinois State Fair.

Junior Show Championship Premium Awards: An additional monetary award of \$15.00 will be given to the exhibitor of the Best in Show Rabbit and an additional \$10.00 award will be given to the exhibitor of the rabbit judged Reserve Best in Show

Best of Breed Champions: Championships will receive additional premium awards with the Best of Breed receiving an additional \$3.00 and Best Opposite Sex an additional \$2.00.
