If entry deadline falls on a Saturday or Sunday, entries must be postmarked by the following Monday.

An entry fee of **\$5.00 per exhibit** is required for adult entries in this department. An entry fee of **\$1.00 per exhibit** is required for teen, youth, and child entries in this department.

General Requirements & Criteria for Competition

- 1. General rules apply to all divisions in this department. Please read carefully.
- 2. This department is limited to amateur Illinois artists. An amateur is one who creates art as a hobby or past time and does not regularly present artwork for sale. Artist must reside in Illinois. Amateur artists aged eighteen (18) are eligible to enter the adult categories. Teen, Youth and Children divisions are for amateur artists ages four (4) through seventeen (17). Exhibitors should enter the appropriate age category based on their age as of September 1, 2023 (for example, someone with a December birthday who was 17 on September 1, 2023, would enter the teen category, because their age as of September 1, 2023, was 17). Exhibitors are responsible for submitting entries in the correct age category. In the event that an exhibitor enters the wrong age category, any award for their exhibit will be forfeited.
- 3. All work must have been created since August 1, 2023, and not previously exhibited at the Illinois State Fair.
- 4. Entries must be original and may not include objects which are copyrighted, trademarked, or owned/assembled in whole or part by someone else and not the original design of the artist. This includes but is not limited to pre-molded ceramics or work that is licensed, copied or created by other artists. Items made with the use of a "kit" will not be accepted. The use of artificial intelligence (A.I.) or computer-generated graphics that are not the original design of the artist are prohibited.
- 5. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class except in the Photography category. Artists entering in the photography category may only enter in one of the four classes. For example, if an exhibitor enters the People class, they cannot also enter the Still Life.
- 6. Entries will be accepted in person at the Expo Building on Sunday, August 4, 2024, from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Monday, August 5, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Work may also be shipped to the following address: Amateur Art Exhibit, c/o Entry Department, 801 Brian Rainey Avenue, Illinois State Fairgrounds, Springfield, Illinois 62702. All entries must be received by 6:30 p.m. on Monday, August 5, 2024, to be eligible for judging.
- 7. Instructions for preparing artwork:
 - a. All two-dimensional entries must be suitably matted (white or black mat preferred), framed and have sturdy wire attached to the back ready for hanging.
 - b. The following hardware devices are not acceptable: sawtooth, cardboard cutouts for hanging, string, monofilament, and scotch tape. Work using these devices to hang or display will not be accepted.
 - c. Paintings on wrapped canvas with wire attached to back ready for hanging are acceptable.
 - d. Small or fragile sculptures should be placed and secured inside a display box.
 - e. Entry tag must be secured to each piece of artwork, preferably on the back or bottom. Entry tags will be mailed to exhibitors from the Entry Department. Entry tags will not be mailed after July 26, 2024. To receive tags after that date, please contact the Entry Department.
 - f. Each Adult exhibit must have a white 3" x 5" card with the artist's name, hometown, title of artwork, and category/class entered. Information must be typed. These index cards will be displayed next to all adult entries.
