INFORMATION

Entries

Required fees include \$5.00 Entry Fee per exhibit for adult entries and \$1.00 Entry Fee per exhibit for teen, youth and child entries. A \$3.00 Office Fee is also due for each exhibitor. Entries in all classes shall be made by through the online fair entry system at the Illinois State Fair website. Payment must be made via credit card at the time of entry. No other type of entry will be accepted. Assistance with entries is available at the Competitive Events Office, Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All entries must be submitted online on or before July 15, 2025. Fees will not be refunded. Exhibitors are highly encouraged to bring a copy of their entry receipt to check-in.

General Requirements & Criteria for Competition

- 1. General rules apply to all divisions in this department. Please read carefully.
- 2. This department is limited to amateur Illinois artists. An amateur is one who creates art as a hobby or past time and does not regularly present artwork for sale. Artist must reside in Illinois. Amateur artists aged eighteen (18) and over are eligible to enter the adult categories. Teen, Youth and Children divisions are for amateur artists ages four (4) through seventeen (17). Exhibitors should enter the appropriate age category based on their age as of August 7, 2025. Exhibitors are responsible for submitting entries in the correct age category. In the event that an exhibitor enters the wrong age category, any award for their exhibit will be forfeited.
- 3. All work must have been created since August 1, 2024, and not previously exhibited at the Illinois State Fair.
- 4. Entries must be original and may not include objects which are copyrighted, trademarked, or owned/assembled in whole or part by someone else and not the original design of the artist. This includes but is not limited to pre-molded ceramics or work that is licensed, copied or created by other artists. Items made with the use of a "kit" will not be accepted. The use of artificial intelligence (A.I.) or computer-generated graphics that are not the original design of the artist are prohibited.
- 5. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class. In divisions where there are multiple photography classes, exhibitors are limited to entering only one of the photography classes offered.
- 6. Entries will be accepted in person at the Expo Building. Work may also be shipped to the following address: Amateur Art Exhibit, c/o Entry Department, 801 Brian Rainey Avenue, Illinois State Fairgrounds, Springfield, Illinois 62702. All entries must be received by Thursday, July 31, 2025, to be eligible for judging.
- 7. Instructions for preparing artwork:
 - a. All two-dimensional entries must be suitably matted (white or black mat preferred), framed and have sturdy wire attached to the back ready for hanging.
 - b. The following hardware devices are not acceptable: sawtooth, cardboard cutouts for hanging, string, monofilament, and scotch tape. Work using these devices to hang or display will not be accepted.
 - c. Paintings on wrapped canvas with wire attached to back ready for hanging are acceptable.

- d. Small or fragile sculptures should be placed and secured inside a display box.
- e. Entry tags are prepared for each class entered and will be available at the time of check-in. Entry tag must be secured to each piece of artwork, preferably on the back or bottom.
- f. Each Adult exhibit must have a white 3" x 5" card with the artist's name, hometown, and title of artwork. Information must be typed. These index cards will be displayed next to all adult entries.
