INFORMATION

Entries

Required fees include \$2.00 per exhibit Entry Fee and a \$3.00 per exhibitor Office Fee. Entries in all classes shall be made through the online fair entry system at the Illinois State Fair website. Payment must be made via credit card at the time of entry. No other type of entry will be accepted. Assistance with entries is available at the Competitive Events Office, Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All entries must be submitted online on or before July 15, 2025. Fees will not be refunded. Exhibitors are highly encouraged to bring a copy of their entry receipt to check-in.

General Requirements & Criteria for Competition

1. General rules apply to all divisions in this department. Please read carefully.
2. Entries in this department are limited to residents of Illinois.
3. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. This applies for open and youth exhibitors.
4. No exhibit or part thereof may be entered in more than one class.
5. Only one entry may be made in each class for categories in Division 4401 – Antiques, Division 4403 – Collections, Division 4404 – Crafts, and Division 4405 – Wood Working.
6. Two entries may be made in each class for categories in Division 4402 – Ceramics and Porcelain Art. When making multiple entries the items must be different.
7. An exhibitor or anyone in the immediate family winning first prize in a division one year is restricted from exhibiting the same article in that division at any subsequent Illinois State Fair for four years. However, exhibitor may show a completely different exhibit. Any item that has received first place since 2022 cannot be shown individually or in any other collection at the 2025 Illinois State Fair.
8. Antiques must have information card stating age as nearly as it can be established and any other information that would be of interest to the public. Card must be firmly attached.
9. Entry tags are prepared for each class entered and will be available at the time of check-in.
10. All items must fit on the shelf in cases to be judged.
11. Exhibits will be received at the north entrance of the Hobby, Arts and Crafts Building. All exhibitors, including children, must place their own exhibits.

12. Exhibitors who are unable to bring their exhibits to the fairgrounds, may send them by United Parcel or Parcel Post, addressed to Superintendent, Hobbies Department, 801 Brian Rainey Avenue, Illinois State Fairgrounds, Springfield, Illinois 62702. The Superintendent shall properly place the items for exhibit. Entries must arrive on or before July 31, 2025, to be eligible for competition. The Hobbies Department is not responsible for late mail deliveries. Sender's name and address must be plainly written on outside of package. Entries should have a label attached with exhibitor name, division number and class entered.
13. After an entry has been placed, changes will not be allowed (additions, deletions or substitutions).

Division 4401 – Antiques

Items must be from 1950 or prior. Card stating age as nearly as it can be established and any information that would be of interest to the public must be firmly attached to the entry tag. Lids count for completeness. Cups and saucers count as one piece.

Antiques will be judged as follows:

- 50% - Authenticity
- 25% - Condition of article
- 25% - Rarity

A professional is anyone who sells ceramics and porcelain art for profit and/or who teaches classes.
