Department Rules

- 1. Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies; and General Rules of the Junior Livestock Division as previously stated.
- 2. Each exhibitor must be present to show their own animals unless exempted in advance by Superintendent due to an identified, eligible conflict. A single showring helper will be allowed in the showring for yearling ewe classes only and all helpers must be bona fide Junior Exhibitors.
- 3. Junior Show exhibitors are reminded they must adhere to the Junior Show entry and ring card distribution requirements in order to exhibit in the Junior Show. Open Show entry does not fulfill Junior Show requirements.
- 4. Purebred animals must be recorded in their respective National Breed Book as evidenced by official registration papers or certificate of registration which may be electronic copies. However, no copies of registration or stamped duplicate of official registration will be accepted.
- 5. Registration must show ownership of the animals in the name of the exhibitor or ownership by immediate family members including the exhibitor for the period required in the 4-H or FFA projects.
- 6. A classifier will be used in the Junior Sheep Show Market Classes for the purpose of breed verification. In all instances, the decision of the classifier shall be final. Official classification at the State Fair is not subject to protest.
- 7. The date shown on the registration papers will be taken as the effective date of ownership. However, in determining original origin or ownership, state or federal identification will take precedence over registration papers. Entries in sheep classes must have been the property of the exhibitor and a part of his/her project in accordance with the following dates:
 - a. Breeding Animals, June 25, 2025
 - b. Market Lambs, May 15, 2025
- 8. Exhibitors in the Junior Sheep Show will be allowed two (2) entries per class with a maximum of twelve (12) total entries per breed and six (6) total entries in the Market Lamb Show. Substitutions are allowed during check-in. However, exhibitors cannot show more sheep than the number of animals originally entered.
- 9. No mature rams, aged nurse ewes/goats are permitted in the Junior Sheep Show.
- 10. To be eligible to show in the Junior Sheep Show of the Illinois State Fair:
 - a. All Breeding Animals must be properly identified with a Flock Tag and Scrapie Tag.
 - b. All Market Lambs must be properly identified with a Scrapie Tag.
- 11. All sheep must be penned in one of the Sheep Barns. All pens and stalls are to be assigned by the Superintendent or his/her assistants. Pens will be assigned on the basis of a minimum of three (3) head per pen, unless an exhibitor has only one (1) entry. Animals must be penned according to these assignments. Exhibitors are responsible for additional fencing if needed to separate or confine animals and all pens must be bedded with natural straw, wood chips or sawdust. Exhibitors will be allowed one (1) pen for tack. Additional pens, for any reason, will be at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 12. No living quarters or tarps allowed in the Sheep Barns.
- 13. No appliances, misters, swamp blasters, air conditioning units or cooling systems of any kind will be allowed in the barns.
- 14. Wethers and Market Ewe Lambs will be shown together in market lamb classes.

- 15. All market lambs must:
 - a. Have been lambed on or after January 1, 2025.
 - b. Be properly identified by a Scrapie Tag and nominated in the name of the exhibitor, verified by local 4-H personnel or FFA Chapter Advisor, on or between March 15 and May 15, 2025.
 - c. Be docked and show ready slick shorn before check-in.
 - d. Weigh at least eighty-five (85) pounds.
 - e. Still have their milk teeth.
 - f. Wethers must show no sign of testicular tissue.
 - g. Free of any active fungus and/or sore mouth.
 - h. Be physically sound at check-in and show times.

All of these requirements will be examined by the Superintendent and his/her assistants who, along with the General Livestock Superintendent, shall have full authority regarding show eligibility.

- 16. Market lambs will be tagged at check-in and placed into weight classes based upon declared weights made at check-in. A minimum of ten (10) lambs of a given breed are required for a breed class. Practice scales will be available in the barns for use by exhibitors. At the conclusion of judging for each weight class, the top two (2) placing animals will be re-weighed for weight verification. Animals that vary five (5) percent or more from the declared weight will be disqualified.
- 17. Market lamb exhibitors must fill out a check-in form which will be provided by the Superintendent at the mandatory Market Lamb Exhibitors' Meeting for each market lamb providing the full name and address, legibly written, of the exhibitor and the Scrapie Tag number of the animal. The check-in form and original nomination form must be complete and submitted at the time of check-in and tagging. Registration papers verifying Land of Lincoln eligibility must also be provided for animals competing in the Land of Lincoln show. In all cases, electronic forms will be accepted, however, no phone nominations will be permitted.
- 18. All breeding animals must:
 - a. Have been lambed September 1, 2024, or after and still have their milk teeth with no evidence of permanent teeth.
 - b. Be docked and properly groomed for showing.
 - c. Shropshire sheep must be slick shorn. Wool may be left below the knees and hocks and on the face and head from the poll forward; the remainder of the body is to be shorn to the skin within 10 days of the show date.
 - d. Southdown Sheep must be slick shorn within five (5) days of the show. Wool may be left below the knees and hocks, and also below the eyes around muzzle.
 - e. Free of any active fungus and/or sore mouth.
 - f. Be physically sound at check-in and show times.

All of these requirements will be examined by the Superintendent and his/her assistants who, along with the General Livestock Superintendent, shall have full authority regarding show eligibility.

- 19. Birth dates, as listed on the registration papers or certificates will be used to determine the class division for all breeding animals. Take the show date and count back to the birth date to determine the age and class for the animal.
- 20. A commercial ewe may be a crossbred or a straight bred not eligible for registry. Commercial ewes and ewe lambs must be ear tagged or tattooed for identification.
- 21. Ring Cards will be issued for all sheep and must be worn by exhibitors in the showring at all times. Failure to do so is cause for ineligibility to show.
- 22. Artificial coloring of sheep will not be allowed. Lambs will be white toweled before entering the show ring.

- 23. Muzzles may be used for animal health and welfare at the discretion of the exhibitor.
- 24. When lambs are being judged, they must have all four (4) feet on the ground. No excessive lifting of the animals. Slapping of animals will not be tolerated and is cause for dismissal from the showring.
- 25. Showmanship Contests will be held separately for exhibitors showing breeding animals and market lambs. In both instances, Showmanship classes will immediately follow the final breed show of the day and will be divided into Junior and Senior Showmanship competitions.
- 26. Special awards presented by Breed Associations are the responsibility of those associations and not the Department Superintendent or Illinois State Fair.

Special Awards

<u>Supreme Champion and Supreme Reserve Champion Ewe Lamb</u>: A Supreme Champion and Supreme Reserve Champion Ewe Lamb will be named from the Breeding Sheep Division.

<u>Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Junior Market Lamb</u>: An award will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitors of the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Lamb and Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Land of Lincoln Market Lamb of the Junior Sheep Show at the 2025 Illinois State Fair. Additionally, the Grand Champion Junior Show Market Lamb and the Grand Champion Land of Lincoln Junior Show Market Lamb will sell at the livestock auction of the 2025 Governor's Sale of Champions.

<u>Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Champion Showman</u>: An award will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the Champion Junior, Intermediate and Senior Showman of the 2025 Illinois State Fair Junior Show.
