INFORMATION

Entries

Entry Fees \$3.00 per head; \$9.00 for Market Pens. Entries in all classes shall be made through the online fair entry system at the Illinois State Fair website. Payment must be made via credit card at the time of entry. No other type of entry will be accepted. Assistance with entries is available at the Competitive Events Office, Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. All entries must be submitted online on or before July 15, 2025. Fees will not be refunded. Late entries will be accepted through July 31, 2025, with an additional \$50.00/exhibitor charge assessed.

Show Schedule

Show will be held in Barn 26. Show order will be as classes are listed in the premium book. Show order is subject to change. Exhibitors should watch and listen for announcements.

Department Rules

1. Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies; and General Rules of the Open Livestock Division as previously stated.
2. There are no requirements governing the movement of rabbits within Illinois.
3. Open Show exhibitors are reminded they must adhere to the Open Show registration requirements in order to exhibit in the Open Show. Junior Show registration does not fulfill Open Show requirements.
4. Open Show exhibitors may enter more than one (1) breed and all rabbits must be entered in the name of the owner.
5. Tattoo ear number will be required at time of entry.
6. All Other Breed (AOB) classes are for animals in breeds not separately listed. AOC refers to Any Other Color recognized by the ARBA and not listed. In all instances, if entering 4-Class or 6-Class AOB or AOC classes, please indicate the Breed and/or Variety entered for exhibition.
7. Exhibitors are allowed substitution within a class up to 9:00 am the day of the show. Entry into additional classes is not allowed after July 31, 2025.
8. The Youth Division is open to exhibitors ages 18 and under as of the first day of the Fair, August 7, 2025. Rabbits entered in the Youth Division may not be entered in the Open Division.
9. Late arrivals will not be eligible to show.
10. Rabbits should be brought to the fairgrounds in appropriate carriers. All carriers must have a solid, leakproof bottom. Animals are not to be placed in State Fair pens unless directed by the Superintendent.

11. All appropriate paperwork must be completed and submitted to the Superintendent by 9:00 am on show day.
12. All rabbits exhibited must be recognized breeds of the ARBA as listed in the Standard of Perfection. No crossbreeds are allowed. Breeds and varieties that have not been fully approved by the ARBA are not eligible to show at the State Fair.
13. Rabbits shown must be the property of the exhibitor and must have a permanent, legible tattoo in the left ear. Animals with illegible tattoos or unhealed tattoos are ineligible to show. Additionally, exhibitors are responsible for having the ears of his/her animals clean and knowing the tattoo can be read by officials at the time of check-in and judging.
14. Any rabbit exhibiting signs of poor health and condition, or a pronounced defect or abnormality will be ineligible to show and receive premiums at the discretion of the Superintendent.

Special Rules and Rules Associated with ARBA Sanctioning

15. The show will be run by the latest ARBA rules and filing an entry indicates acceptance of the same.
16. Exhibitors can win only two premiums per class. However, sweepstake points would still count in the order animal’s place.
17. Every attempt will be made to have a registrar available. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing necessary papers.
18. No breeding of animals is allowed without the expressed permission of both owners and the Superintendent.
19. Exhibitors wishing to have a breed sanctioned that is not, may do so on their own.

Special Awards

Best in Show: An award will be given by the Illinois State Fair to the exhibitor of the 2025 Illinois State Fair Best in Show in the Open and Youth Divisions.

Best of Breed Champions: Champions will receive additional premium awards with the Best of Breed receiving an additional \$10.00 and Best Opposite Sex an additional \$5.00.

Open Show Championship Premium Awards: An additional monetary award of \$100.00 will be given to the exhibitors of Best in Show Rabbit in Open and Youth Divisions, and an additional monetary award of \$50.00 will be given to the exhibitors of the rabbits judged Reserve Best in Show animals in each of the Open and Youth Divisions.

Additional Premium Awards: An additional monetary award of \$20.00 will be given to the exhibitor showing the largest number of rabbits in each of the Open and Youth Divisions.
