ILLINOIS STATE FAIR CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

Fair Entry:

- Campground fees do not include admission to the Fair
- Those arriving on or after August 10, 2023, will be required to pay Fair admission.
- One vehicle parking placard will be provided with each campsite ***and must be displayed prominently on dash***. Failure to do so may result in vehicle removal at owners' expense, even if the vehicle has a valid placard.
- Additional vehicles must purchase a parking placard upon arrival at the campground office and park in designated parking lot.
- Lost or stolen parking placards will not be replaced
- Starting August 10, 2023, campers leaving the Fairgrounds and planning to return that same day must have their hand stamped upon exit, or they will be required to pay Fair admission fee upon returning.

Camping Policies & Rules:

- Must check in at Campground office upon arrival BEFORE parking at your camping spot.
- Check in is at 3:00 pm
- Check out is 12:00 pm – any camper not checked out by noon on their last day will be charged for another night.
- **PERMIT MUST BE DISPLAYED:** Campers not displaying their permit will be issued a 24-hour warning. After the 24-hour warning, those still not displaying the permit placard will be subject to tow at the owner's expense, even if the camper has a valid permit
- Camping is only permitted in campground areas designated by the State Fair Manager.
- Camping fees are \$50 per night
- Tent camping fees are \$25 per night (does not include electricity or water)
- Visa, Mastercard, Discover, money order or cash are acceptable forms of payment. A processing fee will be applied to all Credit Card payments. Checks will be accepted up to July 1, 2023.
- If you arrive prior to or depart after your scheduled reservation date, you will be charged for each additional night(s).
- Reservations are only accepted on-line unless approved by State Fair Office
- Priority will be given to Vendors / Concessionaires and Livestock Superintendents.
- Livestock entrants initially requesting to stay 6 nights or longer will then be given priority. Placement is based on your initial request; you may not reduce your stay.
- One (1) campsite per exhibitor and/or family
- Previous year livestock entries will be checked to verify registration and participation.

- Livestock entries will be checked after entry deadlines. If entries have not been made, we reserve the right to revoke and remove your camping site. There will be NO REFUNDS if rules are violated.
- It is prohibited to transfer a campsite to a third party. Using a reservation made by someone else will result in both parties being prohibited from booking future camping reservations.
- July 1st is the last day to cancel reservation and receive a full refund. NO REFUNDS will be issued after July 1, 2023.
- Those not assigned a campsite will be put on a waitlist and e-mailed indicating such.
- Waitlist: as/if additional spots become available, people on the waitlist will be contacted in the order they were placed on the waitlist, between July 1 & August 1
- If those on waitlist are placed, payment will need to be made within 24 hours
- Supply vehicles are not permitted in the campgrounds
- All sites have guaranteed 30-amp service. There are some 50-amp sites but no guarantee. It is the camper's responsible for being prepared for either.
- No awnings allowed on asphalt campsites
- Dump station, showers and restrooms are in the campground area
- Patrons with golf cars must adhere to the rules and regulations of the Illinois State Fair **including permits**, which are issued by the Credentials Office. You must be a licensed and insured driver to operate **any** motorized vehicle including golf cars, scooters, cars & trucks. Violators will answer to the Illinois State Police on the premises. Violators may also be prohibited from booking future camping reservations or renting golf cars.
- All campsites must be kept clean and free of trash.
- Please dispose of trash in the provided receptacles
- The use/possession of Segways/hoverboards is **strictly prohibited** during the Illinois State Fair
- Fires and grills: Open fires are prohibited. Charcoal, gas, and electric grills are permitted. Covered fire pits, one foot above the ground, will be allowed unless there is a burn ban in effect.
- Generator use is not permitted
- Please report any unlawful activity to the Illinois State Police
- ADA accessible camping sites are limited. Campers requesting such a site must provide verification of need, which can include a copy of a non-expired license plate and/or placard.
- Pets are permitted at the campgrounds but must be **always leashed and are not permitted outside the campgrounds**. Owners are responsible for pets' actions and cleanup / disposal of waste. Unruly or aggressive pets will not be tolerated and may be required to leave the Fairgrounds. There will be no refund in such an instance.

Frequently Asked Questions regarding Camping at the Illinois State Fair

1. HOW CAN I APPLY FOR A CAMPSITE?

Application will be available online on Monday April 3rd, 2023, at 9:00 am CST. After May 1st, please check our website WWW.ILLINOISSTATEFAIR.INFO or call the office at 217-782-0775 to check on availability.

2. DO I NEED A RESERVATION?

Yes – a reservation is required

3. WHAT IS THE COST TO CAMP?

- RV Camping is \$50 per night, includes one Campground vehicle parking placard
- Tent Camping is \$25 per night
- Additional Campground vehicle parking placards will be available at the Campground office for \$40
- Admission Books are available online for \$45, includes 11 any day admission passes (WWW.ILLINOISSTATEFAIR.INFO)

4. WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO CAMP?

Priority is given to Vendors/Concessionaires and Livestock Superintendents. Individuals who registered and showed livestock the previous year and/or registered for the 2023 Illinois State Fair (One campsite per exhibitor/family is allowed). Then the general public is placed as space allows.

5. IF I HAD A CAMPSITE LAST YEAR, AM I GUARANTEED A CAMPSITE THIS YEAR?

No – Spaces in the campground are not reserved from year to year

6. HOW DO YOU DECIDE WHO GETS A SPOT?

We receive far more reservation requests than we can fill. Camping assignment is on a first come, first served basis, with priority given to Vendors/Concessionaires and Livestock Superintendents. Livestock entrants initially requesting to stay 6 nights or longer will then be given priority. Placement is based on your initial request; you may not reduce your stay.

7. HOW DO I CHECK IN?

You must enter the campgrounds by coming in Gate 10 off Sangamon Avenue and check in at the Campground Office. DO NOT place camper and then check in.

8. WHAT TIME IS CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT?

Check in is at 3:00 pm

Check out is 12:00 pm – If not out you will be charged another night.

9. ARE ALL SITES FULL HOOK UP?

No – All sites have electric and water, but not all have sewer. All sites have at least 30-amp service, some have 50-amp service, but are limited. Please come prepared.

10. WHAT INFORMATION WILL I NEED FOR THE ONLINE APPLICATION?

A sample application will be posted at least one week before applications are accepted. Please review that to be adequately prepared for the information needed when the application goes live.

11. HOW DO YOU DETERMINE CAMPER MEASUREMENTS?

We assign campsites trusting you've done your homework with a tape measure. Our sites vary in length. If you have a hitch or spare tire, include them in your length measurement. Forget guessing. Measure. Misrepresentation of camper dimensions could result in the loss of campsite.

12. WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE A CAMPSITE?

We will begin processing applications in April. Notifications will be sent in May, via e-mail if your application was approved, which will include your placement and payment information.

13. WHAT IF I HAVEN'T SUBMITTED MY LIVESTOCK ENTRIES YET?

After livestock entry deadlines we work with the Competitive Events Department to ensure entries have been submitted. There will be NO REFUNDS if rules are violated.

14. WHEN DO I PAY?

Payment will be due in full no later than Close of Business on July 5, 2023. Payment details will be included in your Approval Notification.

15.DO YOU HAVE A WAITLIST?

There is a waitlist. Those who have been notified they are on the waitlist will be notified as soon as possible after the July 5th payment deadline.

16.ARE ANIMALS ALLOWED IN CAMPGROUND AREA?

Pets are permitted at the campgrounds but must be **always leashed and are not permitted outside the campgrounds**. Owners are responsible for pets' actions and cleanup / disposal of waste. Unruly or aggressive pets will not be tolerated and may be required to leave the Fairgrounds. There will be no refund in such an instance.

17.ARE ANIMALS NOT BEING SHOWN ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS?

The only animals allowed outside of the campgrounds are service animals as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Service animals do not include emotional support or comfort animals.

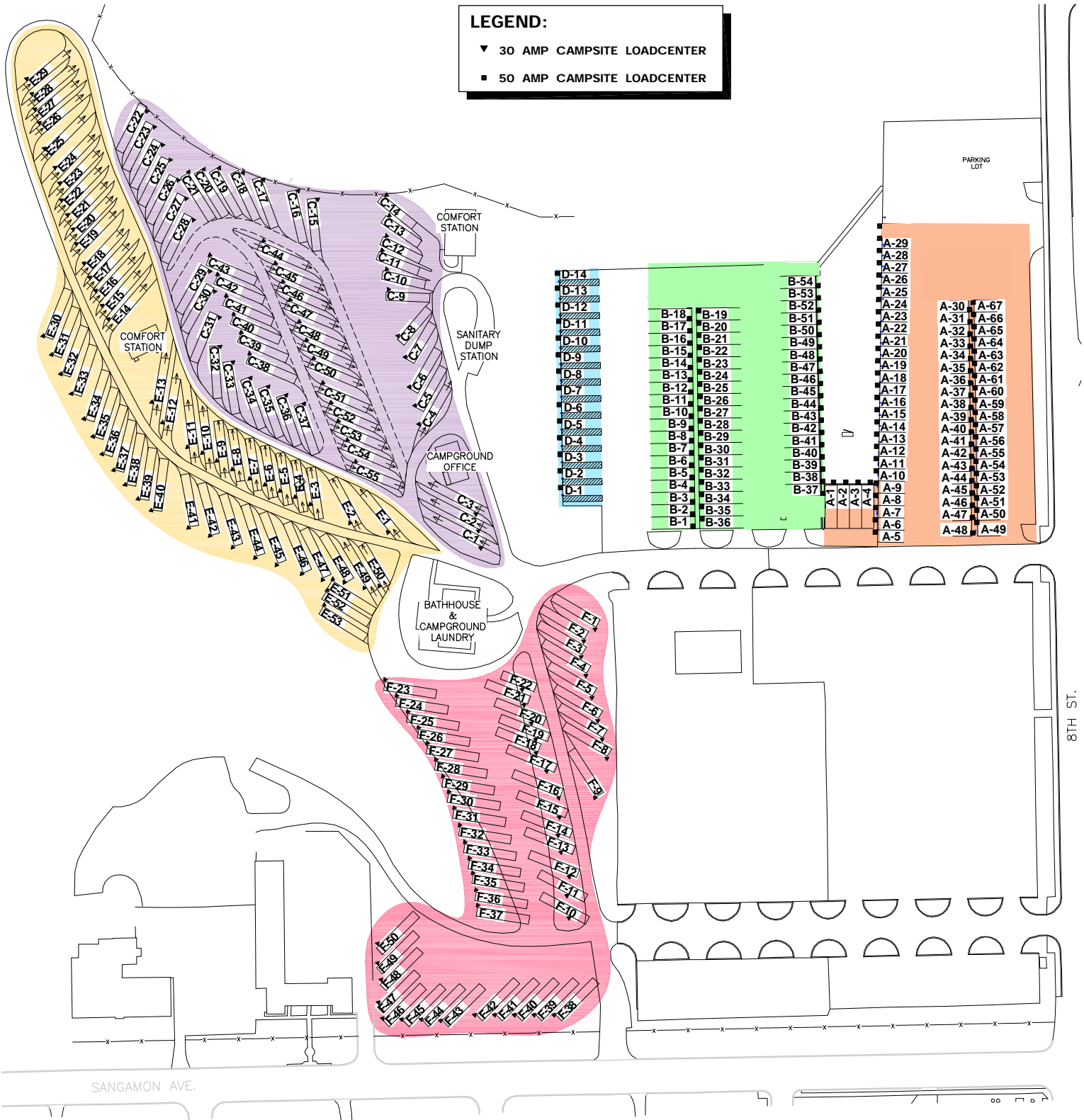
18.CAN I MAKE CHANGES TO MY RESERVATION AFTER I'VE SUBMITTED IT?
